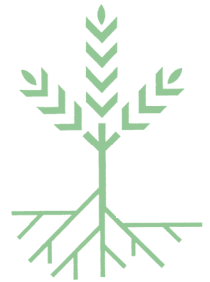


# WORKSHOP: FOREST SEEDLING QUALITY

This hands-on workshop will cover several areas of forest seedling quality assessment. Participants will have a unique opportunity to observe and practice these techniques first hand as well as to learn about their application to nursery and field settings.

- cold hardiness
- root growth potential

- bud development

- morphology
